**Male voice:** Ona e fai au tamaiti laiti... ua faasolo pisi le olaga, ia faate'a ese nisi mea ma oe... Oute lē popole iai.

**Child voice:** Ei, Tamā! Taumafai e pu'e a'u!

**Sound effects:** *We hear him try to chase the girl, but it doesn't take too many steps before he runs out of breath. We hear him puffing heavily.*

**Male voice:** Ae peita'i ina ua ou faato'ā iloa ua aafia ai lo'u soifua maloloina... ona lagona ai lea o lo'u popole ua tupu mai.

**Daughter:** Sau ia Tamā!

**Announcer:** O le tele o mea ete maua, o le tele fo'i lea o mea ete faaalu.
